## SPARKLING & CHAMPAGNE

### France

<b>Champagne Vauban Frères Brut Special Cuvée NV</b>	<b>40.00</b>
Fine bubbles and light sparkling mousse with a fresh, light, lively and balanced palate.	
<b>Crémant de Loire Les Quarterons Brut, Domaine Amirault NV</b>	<b>33.50</b>
Crisp and clean with notes of lemon, apple, honeysuckle and brioche.	
<b>Champagne Louis Roederer Brut Premier NV</b>	<b>69.50</b>
Smooth and complex with lovely notes of toast and almonds and a fantastic rich and dry finish.	
<b>Champagne Laurent Perrier Rosé NV</b>	<b>85.00</b>
Salmon pink colour, the wine is fresh, rounded and supple, with a long finish.	

### Italy

<b>Prosecco Spumante Extra Dry ‘Borgo Del Col Alto’ NV</b>	<b>5.00 28.00</b>
A delicately fruity aromatic bouquet with a delightful fine mousse and fresh, clean palate.	

### England

<b>Nyetimber Classic Cuvée NV, Sussex</b>	<b>57.50</b>
The origins of the house ‘new timber’ date back to 1086 with an entry in the Domesday Book for the manor of Nyetimber. Delicate and fine with honey, almond, pastry and baked apple flavours.

### France

<b>Picpoul de Pinet Trois Mats, Languedoc</b>	<b>6.75 9.00 26.00</b>
Lively on the palate with notes of lemon, melon and honey finishing crisp and dry with matured crystallised citrus fruits.	
<b>Chablis Domaine Alain Gautheron, Burgundy</b>	<b>32.00</b>
Appley fruit and complex, rich mineral character with fresh steely flavours and lively balanced citrus finish.	
<b>Mâcon Villages, Domaine de Rochebin, Burgundy</b>	<b>28.00</b>
Pale lemon in colour, apple and citrus flavours with a hint of pear, finishing on a lovely streak of steely minerality.	
<b>Sancerre Les Longues Fins, Domaine André Neveu, Loire Valley</b>	<b>35.00</b>
Mineral and herbaceous flavours on the palate with immense long flavours of gooseberries and blackcurrant leaves.	
<b>Pouilly-Fuissé ‘Les Crays’, Domaine Auvigue, Burgundy</b>	<b>44.00</b>
Rich with mineral flavours while a brief maturation in wooden cask adds spice and complexity.	
<b>Sauvignon Blanc Terre d’Or, Languedoc</b>	<b>6.00 8.00 23.00</b>
Fresh, crisp and elegant on the palate, with soft fruit with a refined mineral finish.	

### Italy

<b>Pinot Grigio Ca’ Luca, Veneto</b>	<b>5.75 7.70 22.00</b>
A clean well-balanced dry white with a refined acidity matching subtle peach and pear flavours lingering on the finish.	
<b>Gavi di Gavi Cantine Volpi, Piedmont</b>	<b>33.00</b>
Lemony dry with lingering hints of vanilla and soft-textured dry finish.	

### Spain

<b>Albariño Condes de Albarei, Rias Biexas, Galicia</b>	<b>32.50</b>
Fresh and elegant with a captivating floral bouquet and apple, pear and peach flavours.	
<b>Rueda Blanco Marqués de Riscal</b>	<b>29.50</b>
The first Rioja house to develop wines in Rueda. A bright, straw-yellow colour, crisp and refreshing, with a long, slightly saline mineral finish.	

### New World

<b>Sauvignon Blanc Wairau River, Marlborough, New Zealand</b>	<b>7.50 10.00 28.50</b>
A pioneer in Marlborough introducing Sauvignon Blanc here in 1978. Clean and crisp with flavours of grapefruit, gooseberry, herbs and white stone fruit.	
<b>Viognier La Playa, Colchagua Valley, Chile</b>	<b>27.00</b>
An easy drinking white with flavours of dried fruits and lychee enliven a fresh and dry palate.	
<b>Chenin Blanc Backsberg, Paarl, South Africa</b>	<b>28.50</b>
Ripe fruit and a balanced acidity to give a mouth filling, yet refreshing palate.	
<b>Chardonnay Hamilton Heights, South Eastern, Australia</b>	<b>6.00 8.00 23.00</b>
An elegant wine with tropical fruit notes of mango and pineapple combined with ripe peach and pear and crisp acidity.	
<b>Riesling Polish Hill River, Paulett Wines, Clare Valley, Australia</b>	<b>31.50</b>
Flavours of lime, citrus and white blossom with a fresh, racy acidity and a distinct minerality comes through.	
<b>Chardonnay Sur Lie Bon Vallon, De Wetshof, Robertson, South Africa</b>	<b>31.00</b>
The first producer of Chardonnay in South Africa having smuggled in vine cuttings from Burgundy! A vibrant, lemony dry wine with a yeasty and delicate nutty finish.	
<b>Sauvignon Blanc Deep Down ‘Wild Ferment’, Marlborough, New Zealand</b>	<b>39.50</b>
Hailing all the way from Chiswick, Deep Down’s owner Clive Dougall has introduced organic and biodynamic winemaking to Marlborough. An organic wine partially fermented in old oak barrels with notes of kumquat, gooseberry and a fresh lime acidity.	

RED

France

**Château Lescalle, Bordeaux Superieur 32.00**  
Driven by the soft and approachable Merlot with the addition of Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot. Aged in oak and carefully blended, this delicious claret is consistently good, with ripe supple fruit and soft tannins.

**Pinot Noir 1620 Lorgeryl, Languedoc 6.75 9.00 26.00**  
Very intense nose, dominated by aromas of fresh blackcurrants.  
The palate smooth with light tannins and flavours of soft black fruits.

**Gevrey-Chambertin, Domaine Lucien Boillot, Burgundy 70.00**  
The Boillot family have been producing the finest red Burgundies since 1850. Originally from Volnay, the family relocated to Gevrey-Chambertin 100 years later. A real treat for lovers of velvety Pinot Noir. Cherry and redcurrant aromas, powerful with fine tannins and ripe, silky fruit lingering on the finish.

**Côtes du Rhône, Domaine l’Amandine 27.00**  
The spice and smoky aromas of the Syrah dominate the bouquet, whilst red fruits and spice compete on the palate.

**La Réserve d’Angludet, Margaux, Bordeaux 55.00**  
This estate is one of the oldest in Margaux and had a chequered history until the Sichel family bought it in 1961 and transformed the fortunes of this pretty lakeside château. Earthy undertones gives way to supple dark fruits, licorice and spice balanced by assertive ripe tannins.

**Brouilly La Bruyère, Domaine Dubost, Burgundy 29.00**  
Ripe with red fruits, smooth and refreshing with morello cherry flavours and a light smoky finish.

Italy

**Salice Salentino Il Tauro Riserva, Puglia 25.50**  
Full and ripe with a distinctive plum and chocolate character, attractive underlying leather and mineral flavour.

**Barolo Tenuta Neirano, Piedmont 48.00**  
The magnificent Barolos’ are the most sought after and collectable wines from Italy. A rich and powerful wine which is velvety on the palate with the distinct bouquet of roses, violets and tar.

**Montepulciano d’Abruzzo Riserva Tor del Colle, Abruzzo 7.00 9.50 27.00**  
Formerly sold as Sangiovese, it was renamed by the proud local workers of Montepulciano. Round and rich with notes of ripe berry fruit, sweet black cherries, a touch of liquorice and a distinctive spicy character.

**Primitivo di Salento Doppio Passo, Puglia 24.50**  
A fresh and aromatic red with an amazing concentration of plum, blackberry, cherry and chocolate flavours.

Spain & Portugal

**Tunante Tempranillo, Rioja 6.00 8.00 23.00**  
Plummy, soft and seductive with typical Tempranillo character of red fruits and liquorice and a soft round finish.

**Tarón Reserva Bodegas Tarón, Rioja 32.50**  
Union of growers from the four most northerly villages of Rioja Alta. The palate is soft with notes of red cherries, red currants, citrus peel, cinnamon, balsamic and toast.

**Vega Tinto DFJ Vinhos, Douro Valley, Portugal 25.00**  
Rich and full bodied but very smooth in the mouth with plum, cherry and mineral elements.

DESSERT & DIGESTIF

**Château les Mingets Sauternes, France 8.00 29.00**  
Matured in oak barrique with luscious character and intense flavours of caramelized fruits, pear melon and almond.

**Elysium Black Muscat, Andrew Quady, California, USA 9.00 32.00**  
The palate has an opulent sweetness balanced perfectly with a fresh acidity and a long, fruity finish.

**Grappa, Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Crociani, Italy 9.00**

New World

**Malbec Punto Alto Proemio, Mendoza, Argentina 6.75 9.00 26.00**  
A key ingredient is the addition of 15% Petit Verdot as used in Bordeaux adding colour and flavour to the wine. Organically grown, great concentration with velvety texture, dark fruits and chocolate on the finish.

**Shiraz ‘Pimpala Road’ Geoff Merrill, McLaren Vale, Australia 29.50**  
Geoff Merrill, along with his shortening with age moustache, is revered as a legend throughout the world as both a winemaker and cricketing aficionado. He would light up any dinner party with his straight talking Aussie humour! A complex rich, leathery palate and a hint of smoky oak and red berry fruit with intense flavours of dark chocolate and spice.

**Merlot Los Caminos, Colchagua Valley, Chile 5.75 7.70 22.00**  
The palate is rich with black cherry and plum flavours with a hint of mineral character and soft, rounded structure.

**Malbec Finca Sopenia Estate Reserve, Mendoza, Argentina 36.50**  
An intense deep red colour with violet hues and complex aromas of plums and ripe cherries and violets.

**Carmenère La Playa Block 13 Reserve, Colchagua Valley, Chile 28.50**  
This premium oak reserve Carmenere delivers full rich ripe fruit flavours on the palate and a strong expressive finish.

**Cabernet Sauvignon Brookfields, Ohiti, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand 33.00**  
Hawke’s Bay situated on the North Island is the best region for New Zealand’s Bordeaux style reds. Rich and full with notes of ripe bramble fruits, dried herbs and tobacco with some subtle spicy oak and vanilla.

**Tannat ‘Chimichurri’ Pisano Family Vineyards, Progreso, Uruguay 31.50**  
A subtle sweet spice and smoke character with notes of plums, blackberries and damson fruit.

**Ladybird Red Laibach, Stellenbosch, South Africa 33.00**  
So called as ladybirds are distributed throughout the vineyards to keep the aphids at bay. An example of great organic winemaking by Francois Van Zyl here with each vintage differing slightly with careful blending of five Bordeaux varietals. Good structure with plum and mineral complexity and a lingering finish.

**Pinot Noir ‘Roaring Meg’, Mt Difficulty, Central Otago, New Zealand 36.00**  
Named after a successful and gregarious local business woman when Otago became a mining town in the 19th Century. Rightly acclaimed as one of the best regions in the world for the production of Pinot Noir. A lovely mix of red and black berry fruits with oak spice and sweet berry.

ROSÉ

**Whispering Angel Château d’Esclans, Provence 38.00**  
This iconic rosé enjoyed on every luxury yacht across the world! From the same stable as Garrus which is the most expensive rose produced. Elegant summer fruits with faint cherry nuances and beautifully integrated balancing acidity.

**Essenciel Château Paradis, Coteaux d’Aix en Provence 6.75 9.00 26.00**  
Elegant and dry with aromatic fruit aromas derived from a vibrant blend of Cabernet and Syrah.

Italy

**Pinot Grigio ‘Ramato’ Il Barco, Veneto 5.75 7.70 22.00**  
Dry and well balanced with soft, red fruit flavours on the palate.

England

**Chapel Down Rosé, Tenterden, Kent 7.75 10.50 30.00**  
The UK’s largest vineyard in The Garden of England. Redcurrants and floral notes on the palate lead to a crisp, refreshing finish.

USA

**White Zinfandel Sun Gate, Central Valley 25.50**  
Medium bodied with a hint of sweetness and flavours of red cherries, raspberries and strawberries and cream.
